

**Putnam Special Services District
Annual District Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by Chair Anne St.Onge with a total of 22 people present and 18 of those as eligible voters. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

To Choose a Moderator: Richard DiVincenzo made a motion to nominate District Chair Anne St.Onge as moderator, Second by Gloria Marion. Motion made by William St.Onge to close nominations, second by Gloria Marion. Vote to elect Anne St.Onge as moderator was unanimous.

To Consider and Act upon the recommendations of the District Authority Board that Appropriations Be made for the Fiscal Year Budget in the total amount of \$5,720,069 for the period beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027: Floor was opened for discussion with no members coming forward with questions or comments. Motion made by William St.Onge to proceed with vote for the Fiscal Year 2026/2027 as presented, Gloria Marion seconded and all were in favor. Voting took place by secret ballot. Vice Chair Joseph Carvalho and Member Normand Perron counted ballots with 16 “Yes” and 2 “No” votes. Proposed budget for FY 2026-2027 was adopted.
